Head Office accommodation

AMT Head Office will be moving to new premises in Ultimo in late May. The new office will be located in Suite 3.02, 22 – 36 Mountain Street, Ultimo.

Disciplinary Matters

AMT continues to cooperate with private health insurance funds to address the risks associated with health insurance fraud, and poor compliance with AMT's professional and ethical standards. The AMT Code of Practice informs and underpins the Board's activities in this area.

There is ongoing discussion at Board level of strategies to assist AMT members to address any gaps in knowledge and application of appropriate record keeping protocols. AMT members are advised to review the AMT Code of Practice with particular reference to the Record Keeping and Receipting standards.

A number of AMT members are currently undergoing a desk audit of their record keeping.

Investigations into the operation of a chain of massage practices are ongoing. The AMT discipline committee has embarked on a desk audit of 10 AMT members in connection with this investigation.

Regional branches

The Board resolved to provide greater administrative support to one of AMT's regional branches, to help manage large attendances and increasingly burdensome registration processes at the commencement of each meeting.
