

fact sheet - transfer to maternity membership

AMT has maternity leave provisions to assist members maintain their membership during the period they are not in active practice due to child-rearing. AMT will waive the annual renewal fee for two years during this period.

How do I transfer my current AMT Membership to an AMT Maternity Membership?

All you need to do is email your request to info@amt.org.au and please include:

- Your full name
- AMT membership number
- Date you would like your AMT maternity membership to commence and cease (please note below how your dates are calculated).

How are my AMT Maternity Membership dates calculated?

If you are advising AMT that you wish to request AMT maternity membership, your commencing date will be calculated from the date of your next renewal.

Example, for two-years maternity leave:

- if your current AMT membership renewal date is the 01/02/2018
- your AMT maternity membership will be until the 01/02/2020

How long can I defer my current AMT Membership to an AMT Maternity Membership?

Up to 24 months.

What AMT Maternity Membership fees do I pay?

AMT will waive your current AMT membership fees for the first two renewal periods.

For example:

- if your current AMT membership renewal date is the 01/02/2018
- you will not need to pay fees until 01/02/2020

Do I have to submit my CEUs (Continuing Education Units) points every year whilst on AMT Maternity Membership?

Yes. Otherwise you will be removed from the health fund lists.

Do I still need to submit a First Aid Certificate whilst on AMT Maternity Membership?

Yes. Otherwise you will be removed from the health fund lists.

Do I still need to submit an Insurance Certificate of Currency every year whilst on AMT Maternity Membership?

Yes. Otherwise you will be removed from the health fund lists.

Do I need to complete a new AMT Membership Application Form to reinstate back to my full membership?
