MASSAGE MYTH BUSTING

It has virtually no proven medical benefits and is burdened with a history of amateurish research and pseudoscientific rationalisations. To progress, the profession must understand and renounce its many stubborn myths and move towards therapy based on more plausible ideas and techniques. Paul Ingraham is well known for his work on PainScience.com, has been guiding (and dragging) therapists towards the science for over twenty years.

PAIN MANAGEMENT FOR THE MASSAGE THERAPIST - A REVIEW OF THE NEW DIPLOMA STANDARDS WE SHOULD ALL KNOW
