### HOME CARE PACKAGE UPDATE

After nearly 6 months of working very closely with the Home Care Operations Section of the Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care AMT is excited to announce we finally have a definitive answer in relation to Home Care Packages and Remedial Massage.

The department are currently working on a fact sheet for providers, but they can confirm the decision through their normal enquiry channels.

#### The Department of Health and Aged Care have stated:

Remedial Massage will be approved for Home Care Package Funding providing the following conditions are met.

- 1) The therapists must hold a Diploma of Remedial Massage issued by a RTO under the Australian Qualifications Framework.
- 2) The Therapist is a member of a professional association recognised by AHPA as either an Ordinary or Affiliate member.

The acceptance of AMT as an affiliate member of AHPA means that all AMT members with a Diploma of Remedial Massage or a Myotherapy qualification will fit the criteria. To provide massage under the HCP model a massage therapist be a member of an association that is an affiliate member of the AHPA.

If you have a provider that has withdrawn HCP funding, please ask them to confirm the new criteria with the department. You can also refer them to the AHPA website which will verify AMT are recognised by AHPA as an affiliate member.

#### PARENTAL LEAVE

A reminder that AMT and Fenton Green do offer members parental leave membership and insurance protection.

AMT has parental leave provisions to assist current members maintain their membership during the period they are not in active practice due to child-rearing. AMT will waive the annual renewal fee for two years during this period.

Fenton Green have recently announced a similar program for AMT members that meet certain criteria to ensure members are adequately covered during the period when they are not practicing.

## MOVING YOUR PRACTICE

A friendly reminder from the AMT team that every time you move your clinic location you must update your practice address using the Jotform under the "Practices" tab of your members portal.

Your Provider numbers are linked to your practice address, not to your business name.

Once logged into your members portal click on the Practices tab at the top of the page and you will see the following text: If you would like to make any changes to your practice details please complete the change of practice form here.

Click on the word here which will open the form. You will need to select "Add a practice address" if you wish to add a new location or "Delete a practice address" to remove a location. In 2021, AMT did a thorough analysis of the amount of time involved in processing these changes. It equated to approximately 1 full time staff member per year.


The Board felt it was not appropriate for the bulk of the membership to be subsidising those who were changing practices frequently (sometimes monthly) and, due to the Health Fund systems it is very labour intensive. That is why there is a \$30 charge for each new practice address.

## Effects of massage therapy on preterm infants and their mothers

"We performed a systematic literature search in the Cochrane Library, Embase, PubMed, Web Science, & CINAHL to retrieve randomised controlled trials of premature infants receiving massage therapy and its impact on maternal and infant outcomes [including] infant attachment, oxygen saturation, motor function, reflex, temperature, and calorie intake."


