

AMT Position Statement

The Real Body Exhibition at Moore Park, Sydney

The Association of Massage Therapists (AMT) supports the call to shut down the Real Body Exhibit currently on display at Byron Kennedy Hall in Sydney's Moore Park.

AMT shares the grave concerns expressed through the Australians Against Bodies Exhibit campaign regarding the provenance of the cadavers and specimens on display and the lack of transparency of the organisers, Imagine Exhibition Inc, who have failed to provide documentation of valid consent from the deceased and/or their families.

AMT is alarmed by the credible evidence that the deceased may have been executed prisoners and prisoners of conscience in China.¹ Using human organs and tissues without consent for financial profit is unethical and illegal.

AMT urges the Government to shut down the exhibition and investigate any breaches of the Australian legislative or legal guidelines associated with the display of these cadavers.

AMT strongly encourages members to boycott the exhibition.
